

Symptom	Solution
1 long beep and 2 short beeps when you turn on the system.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * The VGA adapter is not properly seated in the expansion slot is dirty. Reseat the VGA adapter, or clean the connectors with a clean pencil eraser.
No display	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * The monitor and/or power cable is not properly plugged in. * The monitor is not turned on. * The brightness and/or contrast control on the monitor is not turned up far enough. * Computer is turned on. * All jumpers and switched are set correctly.
F1 SETUP error when you start up the system.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * The Setup utility was not run.
Distorted images or a blank screen when you run your software.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * The software is not configured or compatible with the VGA graphics adapter's current video configuration Run VGA.EXE.
No keyboard action	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Keyboard cord is plugged in solidly. * Computer power switch is pressed to the "on" position.
Setup problems	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * System cords are plugged in solidly. * Expansion adapters are properly seated. * All jumpers and switches are set correctly. * Hardware information entered with the Setup utility is correct. * CMOS RAM battery is properly connected.
Options not working	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Expansion adapter is properly seated. * System cords are plugged in solidly. * All jumpers and switches are set correctly. * Setup program is executed after installation. * Hardware information entered with Setup is correct. * CPU clock speed is set correctly.
