TITLE:Infinia Desktop ships with resource conflict (COM2 vs. Sierra modem); Download patch disk<br/>INF918.EXE from Toshiba BBSDATE:09/27/96PRODUCT FIELDS:7130 / Infinia<br/>Failure

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### **INFORMATION:**

### Problem:

Some Infinia desktops shipped with a resource conflict between the Sierra modem and COM2. CompUSA sales people were told to fix this problem before delivering systems to customers, but some CompUSA stores didn't receive the promised instructions and patch disk.

# Solution 1:

Have the CompUSA sales/tech download INF918.EXE (originally FIX913.EXE) from the PC Support BBS. INF918.EXE is a self-extracting diskette image. Run INF918 A: to create the patch diskette. The README. (TXT or COM) file on the diskette has instructions for use.

# Solution 2:

End users can use Win95's Device Manager to remove COM2 from the "Ports" section then restart Windows 95. The former COM2 port just shows up as a "Communications Port" with no resources.

The patch diskette also fixes the timesrv problem which prevents SCANDISK and other utils from running without hanging the system.
